

Rules of Road America for Camping - Private Weekends

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Camping at Road America is meant to be a pleasant family experience; enjoying the attractions the outdoors has to offer. There is 24-hour security and patrols to insure that all campers will be able to enjoy the peace and quiet of the area. We ask that each of you help us to respect the rights of others. **All motor homes and those tent camping must have the proper overnight pass properly displayed.** Everyone entering Road America must have the proper event credentials. Overnight stays are not permitted without formal tent or self-contained RV equipment. All campers must vacate after the last checkered flag of the event. No guests - everyone must have proper **WEEKEND or EVENT** credentials.

MOTORHOME SPACES & CAMPSITES:

Tent or motor home camping is allowed only in the paddock, for participants only. Motor homes are \$50 and tents are \$35 for the duration of the event (Fees vary if event is a public event). Each campsite or motor home must have an adult. Sites must be kept clean and free from all debris. Glass bottles or containers are not permitted. We assume no responsibility for loss, theft or damage to personal property. A waste dump station is available in the West Paddock adjacent to the medical facility. Water is available on pit lane or in the Carousel where there is also another dump station. **Electrical hook-ups are available in the trees motor home park or in the upper paddock area, which is an additional charge of \$20.** This privilege can be purchased at the 4-Mile Merchant store in Competition Paddock. There are **NO** water hook-ups available.

QUIET TIME:

Please observe a quiet time between 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M. daily. Children must not be left unattended and all campers should try to remain at their campsite after dark. Please remember, voices carry in the night. Use of profanity, loud music, obnoxious disturbances or nuisances will not be tolerated and will be asked to leave. No radios after 10:00 P.M. and absolutely no loud music at any time. **Sounds made at your campsite should be heard only at your campsite during quiet time.**

ENTRANCE GATE/REGISTRATION:

Participants should enter through Gate 6. Each club will determine a place for registration at which participants can also purchase their tent camping or motor home permits. Once participants have gone through the proper registration and have paid to stay on the property, they are allowed to enter/exit the facility anytime through Gate 6. If you are returning to the track after dark, please drive carefully and observe a 5 MPH speed limit. Be prepared to show proper credentials (wristband). For Road America Security or in an emergency call 920-892-2663. **DO NOT CALL 911!** This can delay help from getting to you as our security force is in direct contact with on-site medical personnel and the county dispatch.

MOTOR VEHICLES:

All operators of any motor vehicle on Road America property must possess a valid driver's license. Any vehicles driven after dark must have headlights. Unlicensed vehicles (ATV's,

Scooters, private golf cars, etc.) can be used by competitors ONLY who must show proof of competition and register such vehicles at registration or the administrative office (fee does apply).

ROLLERBLADES, BICYCLES & SKATE BOARDS:

Rollerblades, Roller Skates and Skate Boards are not allowed anywhere on Road America property. Bicycle riding is permitted in the general spectator areas. Riding bicycles in the Competition Paddock area is prohibited with the exception of race competitors and team members.

PETS:

Pets are not allowed without Road America permission. Pets allowed must be kept under the control of a leash or kept in your vehicle with adequate ventilation and water. Pets are not permitted in Paddock areas during spectator events.

FIRES:

No open fires. Fires must be built in a device designed for elevating a fire off of the ground such as a grill or patio fire pits (available at any local sporting goods store). Fires are permitted when weather conditions are normal (no high winds or dry conditions) and must be placed in a manner as not to endanger other people or property. Gasoline should not be used to light fires! Security officers, Road America staff and safety personnel reserve the right to instruct campers to extinguish any fires they feel are too big or that threaten other campers. Fires must be completely extinguished before discarding coals or ashes in containers clearly marked for that purpose. Violators of fire rules will pay a minimum fine of \$50 for each infraction.

DESTRUCTION:

Please **do not** drive stakes or poles into any asphalt surfaces. **Do not** deface, cut, drive nails into or attach lines or any other objects to trees, bushes, light poles, site sign posts or buildings. The State of Wisconsin has fines for those who destroy wild flowers, trees, or harm wildlife. There are more than 20 different species of wildlife located on over 628 acres of Road America's property. Enjoy what is around you - take only what you brought. No dishwashing allowed in restrooms.

DRUGS, EXPLOSIVES:

Non-prescription and illegal drugs are not permitted. Fireworks, firearms, potato launchers or any type of explosive are not allowed at Road America. Possession of such items will result in immediate removal from the property and further prosecution from local law enforcement.

Failure to observe the rules of this facility will result in instant cancellation of your camping privileges. You will be evicted without refund and parties involved will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law. Road America reserves the right to refuse entrance at the gate.
